

Fixed Income Trader

Knowledge of fixed income securities and the fixed income markets is required. Experience trading taxable fixed income securities and a CFA Charterholder, or progress toward, are preferred.

The primary role of the position is to execute transactions generated within the team process, and it is not based upon the individual taking individually determined risk.
